The TAAF (Texas Amateur Athletic Federation) regional swim meet will be held in Navasota on Saturday, July 24th.

Each swimmer may participate in 3 events (including relays). The entry fees will be paid by the City of Huntsville. Swimmers who finish in 1st or 2nd place (or alternates) will advance to the TAAF Summer Games of TEXAS in Waco on August 5-8, 2010.

Swimmers who want to participate need to contact Karin Williams (295-2668 or robkarin@suddenlink.net) because they must be registered as "TAAF athletes" on the TAAF registration website apart from signing up for specific events. To register in the TAAF system, a swimmer will need to provide their name, date of birth, address, phone number, e-mail address, and which events they wish to swim.

This event is open to any individual who has not participated in any organized or unorganized swim program from January 1 through April 30 of this year. Exceptions to this rule are: 1) school-related activities, 2) off-season swim clinics (2 per month allowed), 3) family lap swimming programs, and 4) swimmers 15 years old and up.
